

Release of Liability and Indemnification Agreement

I acknowledge that I voluntarily have applied to participate and use, with my dog(s), the River Rock Swim and Racquet LLC swimming pool for the Pooch Plunge event on September 11, 2011.

I understand that the act of unleashing my dog(s) and being physically present inside the pool area necessarily involves risks of injury to me, to other people, to my dog(s), and to other dogs. I understand these risks are entirely my responsibility. I expressly assume these risks. I am aware of the risks and hazards inherent upon entering the pool area and I choose to voluntarily enter the premises, knowing the conditions might become more hazardous and/or dangerous for myself and/or dog(s) and I voluntarily assume all such risks, loss, damages, or injury that may be sustained by entering the pool.

By signing this release of liability and using the pool, I hereby fully and forever release and discharge the owners and employees of River Rock Swim and Racquet LLC, the Friends of Millbrook Dog Park and their volunteers, employees and agents from any claims, demands, damages, rights of action or causes of action present or future, whether the same be known or unknown, anticipated or unanticipated, resulting from or arising out of my use or intended use of the pool. I fully and forever release and discharge the owners and employees of River Rock Swim and Racquet LLC, the Friends of Millbrook Dog Park and their volunteers, employees and agents from any and all negligent acts and omissions in the same.

By signing this agreement I also agree to indemnify the owners and employees of River Rock Swim and Racquet LLC, the Friends of Millbrook Dog Park and their volunteers, employees and agents from any claims, demands, damages, rights of action or causes of action present or future, whether the same be known or unknown, anticipated or unanticipated, brought against any or all of such entities based on my use or intended use of the pool.

As a dog owner/handler or as a guest at this event, or as the parent of minor children, I have carefully read this release of liability and understand and fully agree with its contents. I further agree to comply with the rules of the event stated at the right.

This is a release of liability. Anyone using the pool during this event must sign this waiver.

Save Time by Completing this Form and Bringing it With You!

- Each participant must have a Release of Liability and Indemnification Agreement filled out completely and signed.
- All dogs must have current vaccinations (rabies, distemper, parvo virus and bordetella).
- Do not bring dogs that have health conditions that may endanger themselves or others.
- Any dog that has suffered from diarrhea within two weeks prior to the event may not participate.
- Humans may not submerge their heads underwater.
- Your dog may be released from their leash upon entering the pool deck area, past the entrance.
- No children under the age of 18 are allowed without adult supervision.
- Your dog must remain under your control and supervision at all times. Know your dog's personality. If he/she is acting aggressively, please wait until you can calm him/her down before unleashing. If your dog continues to act aggressively, you and your dog will be asked to leave the event.
- Be sure your dog knows how to swim.
- Help your dog into and out of the pool.
- Female dogs in season are not allowed.
- Outside food and drinks (pet or human) are not allowed in the pool area.
- Dogs are not permitted to use the playground equipment.
- Small dogs are permitted to use the kiddie pool.
- Dogs may use the diving boards and the water slide.
- Please ensure your dog has gone to the bathroom **before** entering the pool area. One fecal accident in the pool will ruin it for everyone!
- Please clean up after your dog if they poop anywhere on swim club grounds.

Notify a staff person or volunteer if you have any questions or need assistance.
